The money supply is all the currency and other liquid instruments in a country's economy on the

date measured. The money supply roughly includes both cash and deposits that can be used almost as easily as cash. Government issues paper currency and coin through some combination of their central bank and treasuries. Bank regulators influence the money supply available to the public through the requirement placed on banks to hold reserves, how to extend credit and other regulation. An increase in the money supply typically lowers interest rate, which in turn generates more investment and puts more money in the hands of the consumers.

The supply of money is a stock concept. It refers to the total stock of money held by the people of country at a point of time.

- a) Supply of money refers to the quantity of money(as on 31st march, as on any point of time)*
- b) The stock of money with the money issuing authorities.....part of the money supply. (form, does not form)*
- c)deposit constitutes money supply (demand, fixed)*

d)The claim of one bank against the other.....part of the money supply. (form, does not form)
